

Community Action Promise Award

Description: This award recognizes an individual who has contributed significantly to the Community Action Network, its programs, and activities and exemplifies the true meaning of Community Action. The recipient demonstrates the willingness to go the extra mile to help people in need, respects all people, and is dedicated to the mission and values of Community Action. This award will be given to a current Community Action Agency employee and/or a non-employee who has made significant contributions to the Community Action Network. Non-employees may include CAA board members, volunteers, CSBG State Agency staff, public officials, representatives of a corporation, or community members.

Nomination Instructions: On the nomination form, complete or attach the following:

- 1. A written description of the qualities, characteristics and/or factors you feel make the nominee the ideal candidate for receiving the award.
- 2. Site at least two specific examples relevant to the category criteria.
- 3. Provide two support letters describing why the nominee should receive the award. These letters of support should come from someone other than the nominator.
- 4. Include supporting documentation, if appropriate, including news stories, newsletter articles, etc. (Please note: all attachments shall not exceed 5, 8.5"x11" documents)

Before you submit your nomination, please read the award description thoroughly and include all of the necessary supporting documentation from the instructions.
